Announce the Establishment of a First Class
FIXED BASE OPERATOR (“FBO”) at the Airport to be known as
MILLION AIR SAN BERNARDINO**

**MILLION AIR TO MANAGE PREMIER FBO FACILITY AND FUEL FARM
AT THE SAN BERNARDINO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT**

Million Air Interlink, Inc. (“Million Air”), the nation’s premier Fixed Base Operator (“FBO”) network, has contracted to establish a world class FBO at the San Bernardino International Airport. The FBO, to be known as **Million Air San Bernardino**, will be located at the northwest corner of the Airport. The FBO will encompass over 32,000 square feet of hangar space, an executive terminal and support facility of over 40,000 square feet and approximately ten (10) acres of ramp space.

Construction of the FBO is slated to begin in the next ninety (90) days with completion expected in the first quarter of 2008. The FBO is being developed by SBD Properties, LLC (“Developer”). The Developer entered into an Agreement in March of this year with the San Bernardino International Airport Authority to develop a world class FBO on the Airport and to arrange for the management of both the FBO and new Airport Fuel Farm. The Developer and the Airport staff have been planning the FBO and reviewing proposals from various national FBO operators since that time. The Fuel Farm is currently in the final phases of design and construction is expected to begin in the next sixty (60) to ninety (90) days with a projected completion in the second quarter of 2008.

Debbie Zener, Executive Vice President of Million Air, said, “Million Air is very excited to have been chosen to participate in this amazing opportunity to develop a facility that truly has no limit to its potential.” Zener added that “None of this would have been possible without the redevelopment of the runway and the many other infrastructure improvements spearheaded by Congressman Jerry Lewis, San Bernardino Mayor Pat Morris, San Bernardino County Supervisor Dennis Hansberger, Loma Linda Mayor

Robert Christman and the other Airport Commissioners. They have positioned the San Bernardino International Airport very well for the future”.

The news of the establishment of the Million Air San Bernardino FBO follows a significant increase in aviation activity over the last few months at the Airport. There are now more than 300 full-time aviation jobs at the Airport and all six major hangars are occupied for the first time in almost a decade.

“The establishment of the Million Air San Bernardino FBO is clearly the most important aviation event at the San Bernardino International Airport since the former Norton Air Force Base became a commercial Airport. This impact will raise the profile of the Airport in the aviation community and its ability to increase the level of activity cannot be overstated” said San Bernardino Mayor Pat Morris, President of the Airport Commission.

The Million Air San Bernardino FBO expects to employ approximately 120 full time employees in its first full year of operation with that number more than doubling in the next two to three years. Support jobs created by the Million Air San Bernardino FBO will also generate significant additional revenue and employment for the region.

“We welcome Million Air to our Airport. The growth and economic activity that they are bringing to our region is exactly the role that we have always envisioned the Airport could play in our community” said San Bernardino County 3rd District Supervisor Dennis Hansberger, an Airport Commissioner.

Loma Linda Mayor Robert Christman, Vice President of the Airport Commission, who was instrumental in pursuing the potential of general aviation activities at the Airport, said, “It is heartening for those of us who have always believed in the potential of the Airport as a General Aviation hub to see the vision coming to fruition.” Mayor of Highland and Airport Commissioner, Ross Jones, said, “We are excited to be part of this very important project, and we’re committed to bringing this airport to its fullest potential.”

“We look forward to developing and operating the Million Air San Bernardino FBO as the premier General Aviation facility in the region, and participating in the growth and expansion of the Airport and the economy of the surrounding communities” said Million Air’s Zener.

Million Air is the nation’s premier FBO network. Million Air has over thirty-five (35) locations in North America, the Caribbean and Europe.
